Elisabeth von Trapp, granddaughter of Baron von Trapp and his wife Maria, will be in concert on Wednesday, March 19 at CoMMA (City of Morganton Municipal Auditorium.) The group Musica Nostra will open the show at 7:00 p.m. Elisabeth's concert will begin at 7:30 p.m. Tickets are \$20.00 for adults and \$10.00 for those 18 and under. Patron seats are available for \$50.00 per person which entitles you to a reception from 6:00 to 7:00 p.m. and the opportunity to meet Elisabeth.

Elisabeth's concert will include sacred and secular music. She was born in and reared in Vermont. Her father, Werner von Trapp's guitar playing inspired her singing, and she has carried on the legacy of the internationally renowned Trapp Family Singers. Von Trapp has performed across the United States, Austria and Russia and released five self-produced albums, including her 2005 release, "Love Never Ends/Sacred Sounds," on which she has arranged some of her favorite hymns, psalms and chants with influences from jazz and gospel, contemporary and classical musical styles.
